Kelly Vincent-Brunacini is a textile enthusiast who advised the SBABM on various textile acquisitions including early quilts and coverlets found in the birthing room collection. She also organized, restored and cataloged the museum's collection of over 120 children's garments and ladies gowns as well as researched and cataloged the museum's collection of children's footwear for a future exhibit of 19th century styles for children.

Kelly offers lectures on various topics related to textile history including presentations built around the SBABM collections, the history of women and textile mills in America and 19th century garments and home fashions.
