"In July of 1848 the Declaration of Sentiments was signed by 100 people at the Wesleyan Church in Seneca Falls, beginning the official struggle of 72 years before women had the right to vote. If there is time we can plan a visit to the McClintock and Hunt family houses in Waterloo. These women were part of the original authors of the declaration.
