

## **Required Safety Measures and Conduct for Museum Visitors During COVID**

### **Updated 7/12/2020**

- Masks are required for entry into the museum.
- Only one tour group is allowed in the museum at one time.
- Tour groups are limited to 10 people.
- Visitors must provide a phone number for a member of each tour group, to be notified for contact tracing purposes if any visitors or staff members test positive for COVID.
- If you have prepaid online or scheduled a tour over the phone, please wait in your car or on the grounds safely distanced from other groups until the previous tour group exits the building and a staff member calls on your group.
- Unless previously arranged, we are providing audio tours for the safety of our visitors and staff. Tablets are disinfected between uses.
- If you have not prepaid online or reserved a tour by phone, please visit our website to reserve a tour or wait in your car or on the grounds at a safe distance from other groups until a staff member comes to check-in with your group.
- Upon entering the museum, please follow staff's instructions for admission and use the arrows and signs posted throughout the museum to progress through the exhibit spaces.
- Please use the hand sanitizer provided for the safety and health of all staff and visitors.
- Area Maps, lists of local eateries, and brochures from partner organizations are stored behind the register, available upon request. Please indicate your interests to a staff member so they can provide you with relevant materials.
  - These items cannot be returned to museum staff.
- Our staff will be happy to answer any questions you may have about our cleaning procedures and safety precautions.
- If you wish to purchase items from our gift shop, a staff member can help you select items from our inventory binder or website. Orders must be prepaid, then staff will fill your order and deliver it to you at your car or on the museum grounds.
