

## **SBABM Cleaning Information for Visitors**

The museum is open for tours 3 days a week, with 30 minutes between each tour session to allow for cleaning of the trafficked areas.

Museum staff work on site two additional days a week, during which the museum is cleaned and cleaning and paper supplies are restocked.

All staff and visitors are required to wear masks. Staff are provided with gloves if needed or preferred. Visitors may also request gloves to wear during their visit, while using our audio tour tablets.

There are 3 touchless hand sanitizer dispensers stationed around the museum. The bathroom has been equipped with a touchless hand soap dispenser.

All railings, door handles, technology, pencils and pens, and other frequently touched surfaces are disinfected with alcohol wipes between tour sessions.

Audio tablets are disinfected with alcohol wipes between each use/handling.

The Bathroom is disinfected after each use, except between members of the same household in the same tour group.

We do not hand out receipts unless requested. We advise visitors to accept email receipts if proof of purchase is required.

We offer masks for sale if visitors arrive without their own. If a visitor refuses to wear a mask, they will need to visit the museum at a later date.

If a visitor would like to join our mailing list, a staff member will write down the contact information or direct the visitor to the museum website.

Gift shop merchandise and local brochures are available upon request. A staff member will collect the requested materials with clean or gloved hands.
