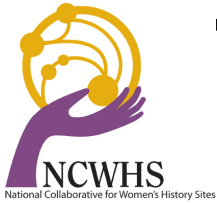

Human rights icon Susan B. Anthony turns 203 years old in February. The Birthplace Museum in Adams, MA, will celebrate with a special tribute to Harriet Tubman — the woman who helped slaves escape to freedom on the Underground Railroad before the Civil War.

Adams, MA (January 19, 2023) — The Susan B. Anthony Birthplace Museum will celebrate Susan B. Anthony's 203rd birthday by honoring abolitionist and social activist Harriet Tubman, who led enslaved people to freedom before the Civil War. The event entitled "The Heart of Harriet" will explore the intertwining lives of Anthony and Tubman during a crucial time in American history. The public is invited to attend.

The celebration will be held on Sunday, February 12, from 3 to 4:15 pm, in the 1899 GAR Memorial Hall at the Adams Free Library, 92 Park Street. Admission is free. The event will also be available to watch live via Zoom or Facebook Live. Register to

The Susan B. Anthony birthplace was restored, and opened in 2010. The two-story Federal-style house at the foot of Mount Greylock depicts family and work life and the Quaker community in the early 1800s, and includes Daniel Anthony’s store, the room where Anthony was born, a portrait gallery, authentic period pieces, ephemera, and a detailed timeline.
