**SUFFRAGE BOSS
ASKS WOMEN TO
SHUN "BOSES"**

**I. E., to Beware of Ad-
vances Made by Man
Politicians.**

New York, Nov. 10.—Women voters of New York were advised to-day by Miss Mary Garrett Hay, popularly known as the "boss" of the Woman Suffrage party in this city, to beware of the advances made by politicians, no matter what party they represent.

"I've been working a lot harder since Tuesday than I did before we got the vote," said Miss Hay, at a luncheon. "I've been spending my time sitting on the lid. The women of New York now have a great responsibility and we must keep our heads. Don't be carried away by the beautiful invitations some of you already have received from political organizations. Keep out of partisan politics until you've learned where you're at.

"Don't be exploited by politicians, you women. They're after you. Be nice and polite to them but don't accept their invitations to join their Assembly District clubs—not yet. And above all, don't be auxiliaries. We've been auxiliaries long enough. Get it clear in your heads that we are enfranchised on an equal plane with the men. We can vote for everything they can, from the lowest local official to the highest in the land."
